The PE department at The English Academy takes pride in offering an extensive, inclusive sports program for our students.

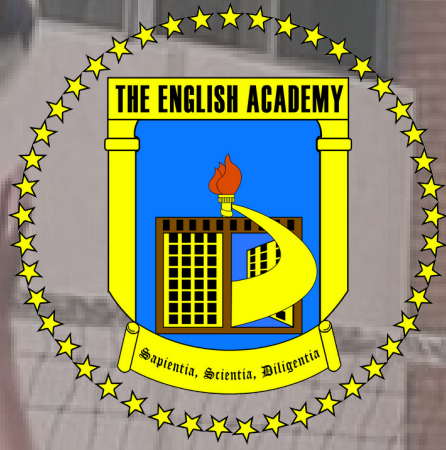

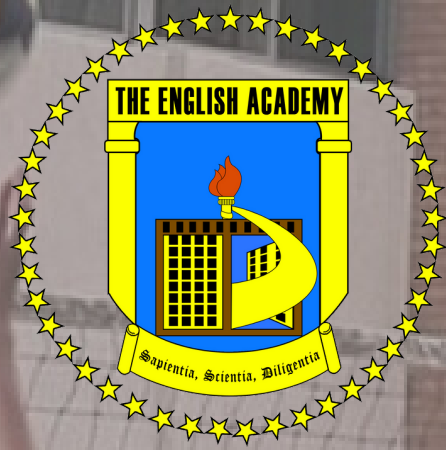

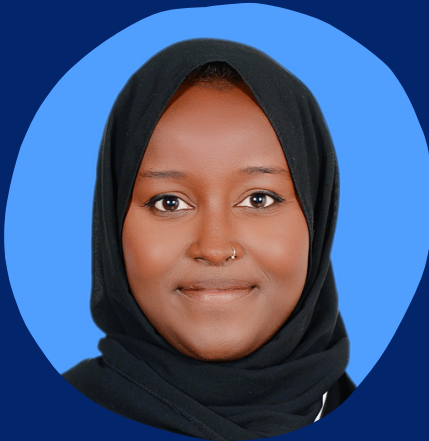
